1. IDENTIFICATION OF THE WORK AND TASKS

Hand tool used to make straight or angled cuts in ceramic tiles, stoneware, porcelain tiles or other hard coverings during tiling or flooring tasks.

2. RISK ASSESSMENT

2.1. Risk Identification

- Cuts to hands when handling ceramic pieces or the cutting wheel.
- Injuries caused by projection of fragments during cutting or snapping.
- Impacts from falling tools or poorly secured pieces.
- Muscle fatigue due to repetitive movements during cutting or snapping.
- Improper use of the traction or lever system.

2.2 Risk Assessment

2.3. Preventive Measures for Identified Risks

- Use cut-resistant gloves and safety goggles.
- Secure the tile properly before cutting.
- Perform cuts on stable and clean surfaces.
- Do not apply excessive force on the cutting lever.
- Check that the cutting wheel is sharp, free of blockages and properly secured.
- Place the machine on a firm and level surface to ensure proper operation.

2.4. Corrective Measures in Case of an Accident

- Cuts: Wash, disinfect and cover the wound. Seek medical attention if it is deep.
- Eye injuries: Rinse with clean water and seek emergency medical care.
- Impacts: Apply cold locally, assess the injury and consult a doctor if the pain persists.

2.5. Evaluation of the Effectiveness of the Measures

- Periodically review the cutting technique, the condition of the cutter, and promote the use of PPE among workers.

3. INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

3.1. Aspects to Consider When Preparing for Use

- Check that the cutter is clean and free of loose or worn parts.
- Place the machine on a firm and level surface.
- Adjust the side stop and mark the cutting line on the tile.
- Wear cut-resistant gloves and safety goggles.

3.2. Aspects to Consider During Use

- Position the tile correctly.
- Slide the cutting wheel applying constant pressure along the cutting line.
- Use the lever or breaking system to split the tile.
- Carefully remove the cut piece.

3.3. Warnings

- Do not cut pieces that exceed the size recommended by the manufacturer.
- Do not force the lever if the piece has not been properly scored.
- Do not work without safety goggles and gloves.
- Do not allow use by minors without supervision or by untrained persons.
- Use only under adequate lighting conditions.
- Do not use if you show signs of fatigue, intoxication, or if you have taken medication or substances incompatible with the work to be performed.

4.1. Cleaning

Clean the cutting wheel, base and rails after each use. Do not leave ceramic residues or accumulated dust.

Apply anti-corrosion liquid.

4.2. Inspection

Check the condition of the cutting wheel, rails and screws. Replace any damaged or worn parts.

4.3. Storage

Store in a dry place, protected from dust, moisture and impacts. Do not stack objects on top.

4.4. Recycling and Environment

At the end of its service life, take the tool to a recycling center for proper environmental management.
