## 1. IDENTIFICATION OF THE WORK AND TASKS

Manual tool used for cleaning coated surfaces, mainly for removing adhesive cement residues, grout, mortar, dust, or other debris after tiling or cladding work.

## 2. RISK ASSESSMENT

### 2.1. Risk Identification

- Skin irritation due to contact with chemical or alkaline products (bleach, grout, etc.).
- Muscle fatigue caused by repetitive movements or awkward postures.
- Slipping while working on wet surfaces during cleaning operations.
- Projection of debris or droplets into the eyes.

### 2.3. Preventive Measures

- Wear waterproof gloves and protective goggles.
- Take frequent breaks if the cleaning task requires prolonged effort.
- Dry or mark wet areas to prevent slips and falls.
- Inspect the sponge before use. Replace it if worn or damaged.
- Use cleaning products compatible with the sponge and the surface to be cleaned.

### 2.4. Corrective Measures in Case of Accident

- Irritation: Wash with soap and water. Seek medical advice if it persists.
- Muscle pain: Rest the affected area and apply cold or heat.
- Splashes: Rinse eyes with clean water and seek medical attention if discomfort continues.
- Falls: Assess the injury, apply ice, and consult a doctor if it is serious.

- Monitor the correct application of cleaning techniques, the condition of the tool, and the implementation of PPE use.

### 3. INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

#### 3.1. Aspects to Consider Before Use

- Check that the sponge is clean and free from visible damage.
- Wear protective gloves and safety goggles if it is to be used with chemical products.
- Prepare the work area and ensure it is free from obstacles.

#### 3.2. Aspects to Consider During Use

- Moisten the sponge with clean water or an appropriate solution.
- Clean the surface using gentle, circular motions.
- Rinse the sponge frequently to avoid spreading dirt.
- Avoid applying excessive pressure to prevent damaging the material.

#### 3.3. Warnings

- Do not use worn or damaged sponges.
- Do not use on hot surfaces or with incompatible products.
- Do not leave the sponge submerged in liquids for prolonged periods.
- Do not allow use by minors or untrained persons without supervision.
- Use only under adequate lighting conditions.
- Do not use if you are experiencing fatigue, are under the influence of alcohol, or have taken medication or substances incompatible with the task to be performed.



### 4. MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

#### 4.1. Cleaning

Wash with water after use. Remove any product residues or dirt to prevent buildup.

#### 4.2. Inspection

Check that it retains its shape and texture. Replace if it shows cracks, tears, or hardening.
