1. IDENTIFICATION OF THE WORK AND TASKS

A manual tool used to apply and spread grout or jointing pastes over tiled surfaces. Specifically designed to fill joints between tiles without damaging the ceramic pieces.

2. RISK ASSESSMENT

2.1. Risk Identification

- Hand irritation from prolonged contact with grout products.
- Fatigue or muscle injuries from repetitive movements.
- Grout splashes in the eyes.
- Slips on wet surfaces during use.
- Handle wear or breakage that may cause loss of control.

2.3. Preventive Measures for Identified Risks

- Wear waterproof gloves and safety goggles.
- Work with periodic breaks and maintain ergonomic postures.
- Keep the work area clean and free of slippery residues.
- Check the integrity of the handle before each use.
- Do not apply excessive pressure that could compromise control of the tool.

2.4. Corrective Measures in Case of an Accident

- Irritation: Rinse with plenty of water. Apply protective cream if necessary.
- Muscle pain: Apply cold/heat and consult a doctor if it persists.
- Eye injuries: Rinse eyes immediately and seek medical attention.

2.5. Evaluation of the Effectiveness of the Measures

Periodically review work habits, the condition of the tools, and promote training on PPE use and ergonomics.

3. INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

3.1. Aspects to Consider When Preparing for Use

- Ensure the trowel is clean, with a secure handle and intact rubber.
- Wear gloves and safety goggles.
- Prepare the work area with good lighting and ventilation.

3.2. Aspects to Consider During Use

- Load the tool with grout paste.
- Apply using diagonal movements to fill the joints.
- Remove excess without damaging the tiles, maintaining even pressure.

3.3. Warnings

- Do not use if the tool is damaged.
- Do not apply on dry or uncleaned surfaces.
- Do not leave the tool submerged in water for prolonged periods.
- Do not allow use by minors or untrained persons without supervision.
- Use only under adequate lighting conditions.
- Do not use if experiencing fatigue, under the influence of alcohol, or after taking medication or substances incompatible with the task.



4. MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

4.1. Cleaning

Wash the tool with water immediately after use. Remove all grout residues before they harden.

4.2. Inspection

Check that the rubber is in good condition and that the handle has no cracks or detachments.

4.3. Storage

Store in a dry, flat place, away from heat or moisture sources.

4.4. Recycling and Environment

Dispose of at an authorized collection point when the tool is in poor condition.
