1. IDENTIFICATION OF THE JOB AND TASKS

A manual tool used to precisely mark the location of holes or drills on surfaces such as tiles, walls, wood, or metal. It facilitates exact alignment during the installation of fixtures or drilling.

2. RISK ASSESSMENT

2.1. Hazard Identification

- Cuts or punctures from contact with irregular or sharp surfaces if handled incorrectly.
- Injuries from contact with irregular or sharp surfaces.
- Marker slipping during use, which may cause accidents.
- Projection of particles when used on dusty surfaces or surfaces with debris.

2.2 Risk Assessment

2.3. Preventive Measures for Identified Risks

- Wear protective gloves during prolonged use or on rough surfaces.
- Use safety goggles when working in areas with dust or loose debris.
- Hold the marker firmly and apply controlled, appropriate pressure.
- Check that the marking tip is clean, straight, and free of deformations.
- Store the tool protected when not in use.

2.4. Corrective Measures in Case of an Accident

- Cuts: Wash, disinfect, and cover with a dressing. Consult a doctor if the wound is deep.
- Eye injury: Rinse with clean water and consult a doctor.
- Blows or marking errors: Assess the area and adjust technique or tool.

2.5. Evaluation of the Effectiveness of Measures

Ensure that workers use the marker correctly and perform proper maintenance. Reinforce training on good practices.

3. INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

3.1. Considerations for Preparing to Use the Tool

- Check that the marker is in good condition.
- Clean the surface to be marked.
- Prepare the tool and work environment with adequate lighting.
- Wear the appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE).

3.2. Considerations During Use

- Place the marker on the desired point.
- Apply controlled pressure until the surface is marked.
- Remove carefully and check the mark before drilling or perforating.

3.3. Warnings

- Do not use the marker to strike or drill materials.
- Do not use if the tool is damaged or bent.
- Keep out of reach of children and away from walkways.
- Do not allow use by minors without supervision or by untrained persons.
- Use only under adequate lighting conditions.
- Do not use if experiencing fatigue, under the influence of alcohol, or after taking medication or substances incompatible with the task.



4. MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

4.1. Cleaning

Clean the tip and body of the marker after each use with a dry cloth.

4.2. Inspection

Check that the marking tip is straight and clean. Replace if it is deformed.

4.3. Storage

Store in a toolbox or safe area, away from moisture or impacts.

4.4. Recycling and Environment

Take to a recycling collection point when the tool reaches the end of its service life, following local regulations.
