

1. IDENTIFICATION OF THE JOB AND TASKS

A manual tool with a narrow, toothed blade designed for cutting laminated plasterboard, thin wood panels, or other lightweight construction materials. It is ideal for curved cuts, interior cuts, or cuts in hard-to-reach areas.

2. RISK ASSESSMENT

2.1. Hazard Identification

- Cuts on hands from contact with the sharp tip or saw teeth..
- Muscle fatigue from prolonged use or incorrect technique.
- Handle breakage or blade deformation due to misuse.
- Blade slipping during the start of the cut.
- Projection of splinters or wood fragments.
- Dust projection.

2.2 Risk Assessment

2.3. Preventive Measures

- Wear protective gloves and safety goggles.
- Accurately mark the cutting area before starting.
- Securely hold the board or material using supports or clamps
- Perform cuts with smooth and controlled movements.
- Avoid working in awkward or strained postures.

2.4. Corrective Measures in Case of an Accident

- Cuts: Wash, disinfect, and cover with a dressing. Seek medical attention if the cut is deep.
- Muscle fatigue: Stop working, stretch, and rest the affected area.
- Splinters in the eyes: Rinse with clean water and seek medical attention.
- Eye irritation: Rinse with plenty of water and seek medical advice if necessary.

2.5. Evaluation of the Effectiveness of Measures

- Review correct tool usage and compliance with PPE requirements. Supervise proper maintenance of the saw.

3. INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

3.1. Considerations for Preparing to Use the Tool

- Check that the blade is sharp, free of rust, and without deformation.
- Ensure the handle is secure.
- Prepare the work area with good lighting and a stable surface.
- Wear gloves and safety goggles.

3.2. Considerations During Use

- Mark the desired cutting line with a pencil.
- Insert the tip of the saw into the board with controlled pressure.
- Carry out the cut following the line with short, continuous movements.
- Remove the saw slowly once finished.

3.3. Warnings

- Do not use on materials for which the tool is not designed.
- Do not use if the tool is in poor condition: rusted, loose, or damaged.
- Do not leave the saw in walkways or without protection.
- Do not point toward people or handle it in an unsafe manner.
- Do not allow use by minors or untrained persons.
- Do not use without eye protection or in low-visibility conditions.
- Ensure proper grip of both the handle and the workpiece.
- Do not apply excessive pressure to avoid damaging the blade or losing control during cutting.
- Do not cut with one hand without properly securing the workpiece.
- Use only under adequate lighting conditions.
- Do not use if experiencing fatigue, under the influence of alcohol, or after taking medication or substances incompatible with the task.

4.1. Cleaning

Clean the blade after use with a dry cloth. Avoid the buildup of dust or debris.

Store in a dry and safe place, preferably with protection for the blade.

4.4. Recycling and Environment

Dispose of at a recycling collection point when it is no longer usable. Separate components if possible.
