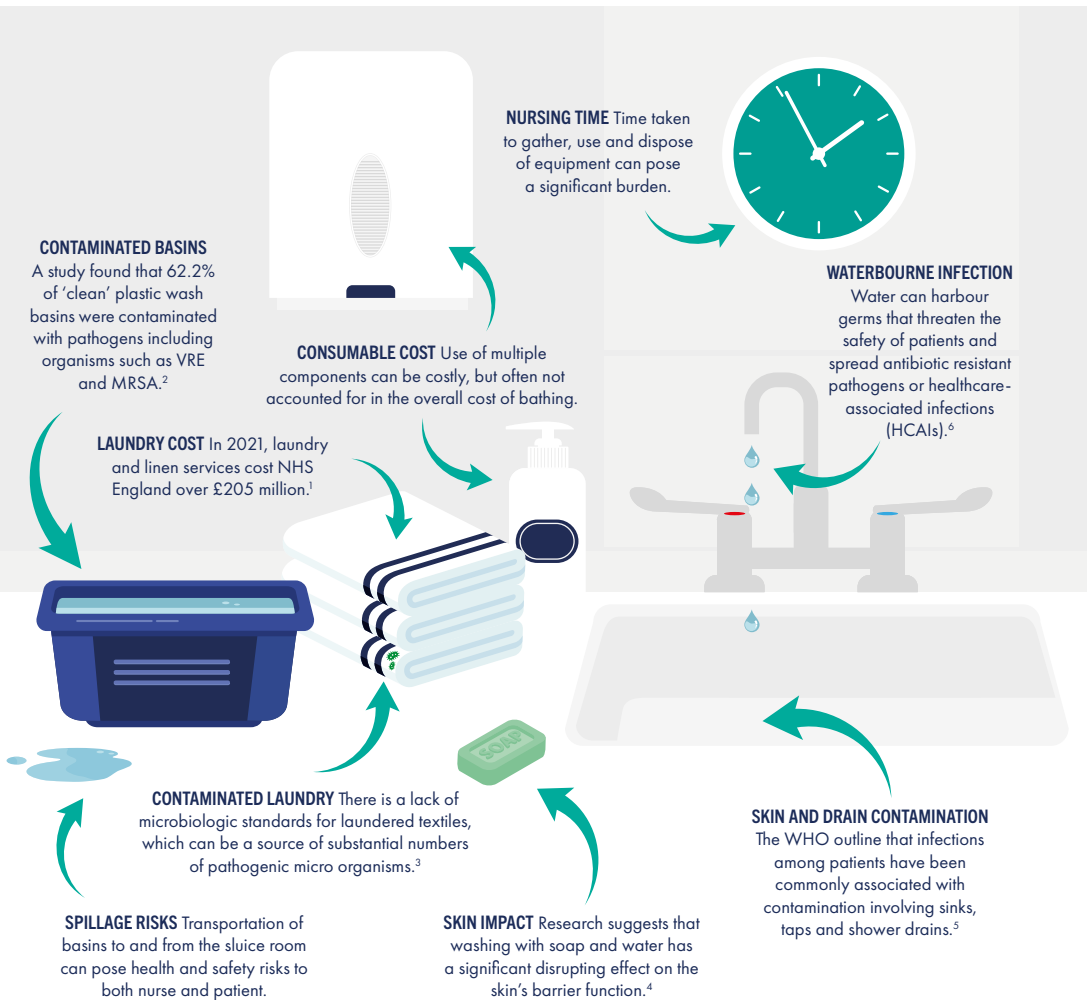

Traditional bed bathing practices using soap and water pose many inherent issues for both healthcare professionals and those receiving bed bound care.



Bathing considerations for those receiving care...

Participation in care

If a bed bath is required, it is important to offer patients the opportunity to participate in their own care, which helps to maintain their independence, self-esteem and dignity.⁷

NICE advise adoption of an individualised approach to healthcare that is tailored to the patient's needs and circumstances.⁸

Maintaining dignity

Best practice suggests that only the area of the body being cleansed should be uncovered and that blankets could be used to limit exposure and provide dignity.⁹

Providing comfort

Those living with dementia may find the rush of water from an overhead shower frightening or disorientating, adaptations should be made to accommodate this.¹⁰

Relationship building and interaction

Assisting with basic hygiene creates a personal connection between care provider and receiver, as well as maintaining health. Bathing is also an opportunity to check for lesions or pressure ulcers.¹¹

Gentle skin care

Ageing has a degenerative effect on the skin leaving it more vulnerable to damage, recent studies suggest that skin wiping pressure during bathing should be controlled and evaluated.^{12,13}
